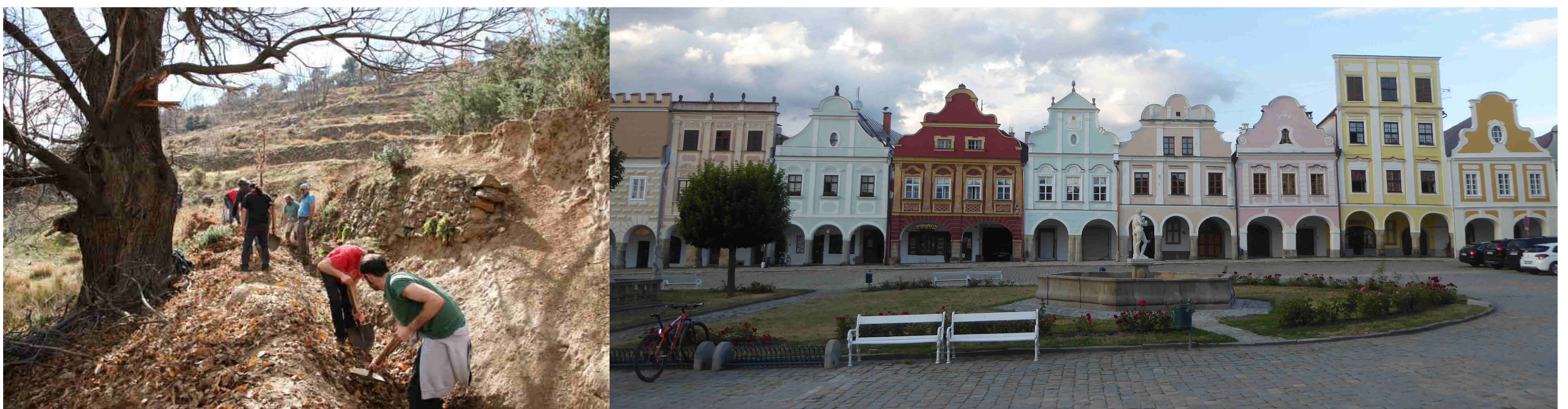
related to social participation in the cultural heritage field!

Each record contains valuable knowledge about participation.



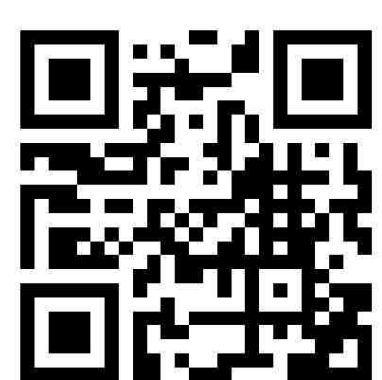
