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Resilience/ resilient cities/ communities

- Resilient cities/ communities: those able to use various resources to respond to or recover from various kinds of shocks, disasters or other adverse situations.
- In times of social media, fake news, conspiracies... growing number of papers deal with building cities and communities resilient to intolerance, racism, xenophobia, extremism... (Ellis Abdi 2017, Muro 2017).
- According to literature, social capital social bonding and bridging is most important in building resileint communities it involves communication, shared values and social cohesion (Ellis Abdi 2017).
- Community competence the ability to collaborate, social linking, trust and connection btw institutions and community members (Norris et al. 2008).
